

RESOLUTION TO ALLOW RESIDENT TAXPAYERS ALTERNATE METHODS TO
PROTEST PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

RESOLUTION #2021-0209-4

WHEREAS, the General Property Tax Act, MCL 211.30(8) makes provision for resident taxpayers to protest property assessments to the Board of Review (BOR) in by letter, e-mail and phone calls; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Greendale desires to assure that all resident taxpayers have access and opportunity to protest such property assessments in the most efficient manner available to the resident taxpayer; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOR shall receive letters, e-mails or phone calls of protest regarding assessment from resident and non-resident taxpayers beginning with the first Tuesday in March until BOR adjourns from public hearings for which it meets to hear such protests; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all notices of assessment change and all advertisements of BOR meetings shall include a statement that resident taxpayers may protest by letter, e-mail or phone call to the BOR.
