

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Greendale Township Board of Trustees held at the Greendale Township Hall

Date of Meeting: October 8, 2024

Time held: 7:00 pm

The regular meeting of the Greendale Township Board was held at the Hall on Tuesday, October 8, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with the pledge to the flag led by the Supervisor, Knopp. Board members present were: Brian Knopp, Supervisor; Ruth L Knapp, Clerk; Juanita Seckinger, Treasurer and Bridget Elkins, Trustee. Absent: Julia Beach, Trustee. Members of the public signing in: see list.

**MINUTES:** Motion, Seckinger; Second, Knopp. Approve minutes of regular meeting of September 10, 2024 as circulated. Motion passed on a voice vote. Corrections: none.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** As reported: Balance on hand in General/Fire Funds of 131,487.16. Solid Waste Fund: 66,387.34 and 202,751.80 in CD's/Savings. Balance in the P/R Tax Acct: 920.49; and Debt Serv Acct: 10.65. No corrections nor adjustments were heard, report accepted as given.

Motion, Seckinger; Second, Elkins. Pay the bills as presented. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Elkins, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea; and Seckinger, yea. Checks numbered 5456-5417 marked VOID-printing error, #5472-5487 were issued from Gen/Fire Funds, checks numbered 2575-2576 from the Solid Waste Fund and no check from Debt Service.

Public comment opened at 7:04 pm. Public comment closed at 7:23 pm.

**BUSINESS:** Motion, Knapp; Second, Seckinger. Contract with Rite-Way Asphalt Paving to pave the entire driveway at the Township Hall. Amend the GenFund Budget by 94,000.00 for capital improvements. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea; Seckinger, yea and Elkins, yea. Work will begin immediately.

Motion, Knopp, Second, Elkins. Purchase a ¼ page ad in the Bullock Creek HS Yearbook for 100.00 to promote the Township facilities. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Motion, Knapp; Second, Elkins. Instruct the TCA Rep Knapp to vote to pay the inspectors as permits are purchased. Motion passed on a voice vote.

It was the consensus of the Board that a contact should be made with engineering companies in the area to request a proposal for improving the former landfill property to a rustic campground, making contacts with state agencies and assist in grant research and writing.

Knopp would like to create a pool of volunteers to assist in developing plans for recreation opportunities and a grant writing committee to search for and secure grants as projects are developed.

**REPORTS:** There was no meeting of the Planning Commission in September.

TCA is discussing pay roll procedure and electronic permitting.

Public comment opened: 8:05 pm. Public comment closed: 8:27 pm. There was no further business brought before the Board. Meeting adjourned at 8:28 pm.
