Meetings of the Greendale Township Board of Trustees are held at 7:00 pm on the second Tuesday of each month at the Township Hall at 4750 West Isabella Road. Greendale Township Planning Commission, Melissa Carroll chairperson, meets at 7:00 pm on the fourth Monday of each month. Holidays may affect the date, check postings at the hall for changes from time to time.

Greendale Twp contracts with Lee Twp Fire Department to provide fire and rescue services for the Township and is paying 84,456.09 for FY25-26. The Township levies 1.0000 mill Fire Protection Tax on the real property to help cover the cost of the contract, it generally raises just over 50,000.00. The Fire dept is always looking for volunteers as fire fighter and first responder from both Greendale and Lee Townships. Anybody interested is welcome to apply, contact the Lee Twp Fire Chief for more information.

PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION INFORMATION

Please read the tax bill carefully. Senior citizens, eligible service personnel, totally and permanently disabled citizens; paraplegic, quadriplegic, may apply to defer summer taxes on or before September 15, 2025. SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING

Republic Services provides the roadside trash pick-up in Greendale Township. Containers are provided for your **bagged** trash and must be placed at curb side, front facing the road at least four feet from any other objects, including other trash containers. Residents must call to arrange for large item pick-up at 800-438-0966. If any problems persist, call the Twp Hall. Republic **DOES NOT** pick up tires, and **DO NOT** leave the tires for Recycling. Geocycle, 4602 W Saginaw Rd, Coleman, phone 989-465-0200, still accepts certain old tires for recycling. Call for more info, cost and drop-off times. Residents are allowed one free load of acceptable materials, up to 3 cubic yards of trash and/or large items, at the Midland Landfill at 4311 E Ashman Road, Midland. Limit one per month per residence.

Greendale Township has secured s grant from EGLE for up to 2,000 tires to be recycled this summer. Vouchers for this grant program will be available after July 1, 2025, call the office to receive a voucher.

Video/Cable TV complaint resolution process outlined in 2009 PA 0004, Section 10 (4)(5) &(6). The MI Public Services Comm will be handling customer complaints. If a complaint cannot be resolved with the vendor, contact PSC at 866-552-7725 or on the website www.michigan.gov/mpsc.

Recycling is provided by Midland Recyclers at the Hall, open 24/7 to **TOWNSHIP** residents. Items **MUST** be clean, caps removed from containers and sorted into appropriate bins. Recycling is picked up weekly. Plastics containers accepted now are bottles and jars, #1 and #2 with seams across the bottom and #5. **Electronic Waste**, Old telephones, computers, TV's, etc, working or broken, can be dropped off at the Midland Recyclers at 4305 East Ashman Road, next to the City Landfill.

Building, Electrical, Plumbing and Mechanical permits: Twp Code Authority, 989-837-6521, Mon-Wed from 9:30 to 3:30 and Thurs from 9:30 to 4:00. Check out their website for more information. In cooperation with the Twp Code Authority and in compliance with Zoning Ordinance #2022-0614, Greendale Twp has implemented the Zoning Compliant Land Use Permit (ZCLU Permit). This permit will be processed by the Zoning Adm/Enforcer Brian Knopp in order to assure that all site plans are in compliance with the requirements of the Twp Zoning Ordinance and the cost is 25.00. <u>ALL</u> building projects must secure a ZCLU permit, WHETHER A BUILDING PERMIT IS REQUIRED OR NOT.

General Information for Summer

- >Summer is here and the fun has begun, please remember your ORV etiquette. ORV operations, MCL324.1131 and Midland County Ord #14 govern the public road use and operations of ORV's. Some highlights are that the operator must have a driver's license, an ORV safety certificate, must drive with the flow of the traffic on the far right of the road, travel in single file no faster than the posted speed or 25 mph, whichever is slower.
- >The Michigan legislature passed a law to make more fireworks legal for all residents of the state. Please remember to observe Township Noise Ordinance time of 11:00 pm when using these more noisy fireworks, respect your neighbors while you are having fun. Don't forget to operate safely, prevent injury and fire.
