

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Greendale Township Board of Trustees held at the Greendale Township Hall

Date of Meeting: September 9, 2025

Time held: 7:00 pm

The regular meeting of the Greendale Township Board was held at the Hall on Tuesday, Sept 9, 2025. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with the pledge to the flag led by the Supervisor, Knopp. Board members present were: Brian Knopp, Supervisor; Ruth L Knapp, Clerk; Angela Brown, Treasurer and Julia Beach, Trustee. Absent: Bridget Elkins, Trustee. Members of the public signing in: see list.

MINUTES: Motion, Beach; Second, Brown. Approve minutes of regular meeting of August 12, 2025 as circulated. Motion passed on a voice vote. Corrections: none.

TREASURER'S REPORT: As reported: Balance on hand in General/Fire Funds of 145,298.24. Solid Waste Fund: 83,126.71 and 107,828.32 in CD's/Savings. Balance in the P/R Tax Acct: 1,045.96; and Debt Serv Acct: 10.65. No corrections nor adjustments were heard, report accepted as given.

Motion, Beach; Second, Knopp. Pay the bills as presented. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Beach, yea; Brown, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea. Checks numbered 5715-3733 were issued from Gen/Fire Funds, checks numbered 2612-2613 and no checks from Debt Service.

Public comment opened at 7:07 pm. Public comment closed at 7:37 pm.

BUSINESS: Motion, Knapp; Second, Knopp. Amend General Fund budget to increase Recreation capital improvements from 15,000.00 to 17,000.00. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Beach, yea; Brown, yea; Knapp, yea and Knopp, yea.

Motion, Knapp; Second, Beach. Accept the proposal from Lapham Services to assist the Planning Commission in updating the Master Plan (5-yr review) including all necessary paperwork for the hearing and publishing at a cost of 7,000.00. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Brown, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea and Beach, yea.

There was a discussion of poison ivy treatment at the Jones M-20 Park, bids are expected for consideration. If a bid is submitted at or under the 400.00 allotment approved in the August meeting, proceed with treatment.

REPORTS: Planning Commission continues to work on Master Plan 5-yr review and possible updates and the review of the current Zoning Ordinance considering Board suggested updates.

TCA: Knapp reported that an additional office person has been hired and discussion continues on the cancellation of the Cloudpermit automated permitting system as a failed program.

Recreation Planning Committee: Working with consultant Don Hamilton toward creating a comprehensive recreation plan. Next meeting September 25 at 6:30.

Grant Writing Committee: Grant applications for ballfield have been submitted and are now waiting for determinations.

Tire Grant status. Knapp reported that vouchers for over 1345 tires have been issued.

Public comment opened: 8:04 pm. Public comment closed: 8:11 pm.

No further business was brought before the Board. Meeting adjourned at 8:11 pm.
