

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Greendale Township Board of Trustees held at the Greendale Township Hall

Date of Meeting: April 14, 2026

Time held: 7:00 pm

The regular meeting of the Greendale Township Board was held at the Hall on Tuesday, April 14, 2026. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with the pledge to the flag led by the Supervisor, Knopp. Board members present were: Brian Knopp, Supervisor; Ruth L Knapp, Clerk; Angela Brown, Treasurer; Julia Beach, Trustee and Bridget Elkins, Trustee. Absent: none. Members of the public signing in: see list.

MINUTES: Motion, Elkins; Second, Beach. Approve minutes of regular meeting of March 10, 2026 and the special meetings of March 17, 2026 and March 25, 2026 as circulated. Motion passed on a voice vote. Corrections: none.

TREASURER'S REPORT: As reported: Balance on hand in General/Fire Funds of 206,432.09. Solid Waste Fund: 112,550.79 and 109,965.23 in Municipal HY Savings. Balance in the P/R Tax Acct: 11.02; and Debt Serv Acct: 10.65. No corrections nor adjustments were heard, report accepted as given.

Motion, Beach; Second, Brown. Pay the bills as presented. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Beach, yea; Brown, yea; Elkins, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea. Checks numbered 5882-5904 were issued from Gen/Fire Funds, checks numbered 2628-2629 from the Solid Waste Fund and no check from Debt Service.

Public comment opened at 7:05 pm. Public comment closed at 7:32 pm.

Motion, Elkins; Second, Beach. Approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed on a voice vote.

BUSINESS: Motion, Knapp; Second, Elkins. Begin working toward networking with other agencies to establish partnerships to assist in developing properties designated as future parks; communicate plans for development of the Jones M-20 Park with Consumers Energy in order to coordinate with CE in development and grant procurement and make contacts with the "Family" Foundations in Midland County in order to secure additional funding and grant matching funds. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Beach presented info about the planned Community Event and set the date for July 25, 2026 from 10 am to 3 pm. Motion, Elkins; Second, Beach. Set the date for the Community Event Day and move forward with plans. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Motion, Knapp; Second, Elkins. Increase Election Inspector salary from 13.50/hour to 15.00/ hour. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Brown, yea; Elkins, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea and Beach, yea.

Motion, Knopp; Second, Knapp. Direct Marc McMillan Maintenance to install up to four (4) posts in the driveway the neighbors have created into the Township driveway. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Elkins, yea; Knapp, yea; Knopp, yea; Beach, yea and Brown, no. Contacting Miss Dig 811 will be the first step.

Motion, Knopp; Second, Beach. Increase mileage reimbursement to .725/mile retroactive to January 1, 2026. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Knapp, no; Knopp, yea; Beach, yea; Brown, yea and Elkins, yea.

Myra Post gave a presentation on a Proposal to Establish an Event Coordinator Position in Greendale Township. Questions were asked and the subject will be considered at the May, 12, 2026 regular meeting.

Knapp reported on efforts to secure reset and testing for CO and NO2 sensors installed in the garage and EMS Quarters. Ino-Tek located in Romeo MI was recommended by Bonham Heating and Cooling, the original installers, as an established company. There were objections because of the distance. Motion, Knopp; Second, Knapp. Board members may seek an alternate service provider by April 16, 2026 and notify the Clerk

of the alternative. If none found by that date, the Clerk will contact Ino-Tek to complete the work at their estimated cost of 815.00. Motion passed on a roll call vote. Knopp, yea; Beach, yea; Brown, yea; Elkins, yea and Knapp, yea.

REPORTS: Planning Commission: Completing work on the Master Plan and preparing to hold the Public Hearing on suggested changes to the 2018 Master Plan.

TCA: Completing work on Budgets. Knapp reported that, in leaving the TCA Board of Directors, another Greendale Township Board member will need to step up and fill that position of representation of Greendale Twp on the TCA Board. This will be an item of business on the May agenda.

Recreation Planning Committee: Will be working on the Community Event set for July 25, 2026.

Public comment opened: 9:18 pm. Public comment closed: 9:20 pm.

No further business was brought before the Board. Meeting adjourned at 9:20 pm.
